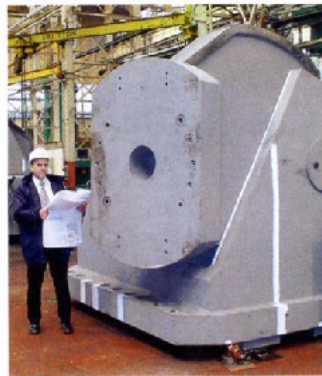

Bearing Wembley's arch

Bearing blocks for the new Wembley Stadium arch were designed by consulting engineers MG Bennett. When the arch is in place each block will carry a load of 3000 tonnes. The arch will be attached to the ground, and the blocks must rotate to pivot it into position. They will then be welded to form a rigid structure.
